Playing Rule 11.4 Discrimination Offences to Date this Season in Saskatchewan

- 52 total calls/allegations (Up 12 from last month)
 - 27 on ice calls reported by officials
 - 20 reports of allegations to officials to be investigated
 - 5 reports of allegations from coaches to be investigated
- 25 investigations of allegations
 - 6 allegations resulted in suspension
 - 1 moved to an 11.2 (f) suspension
 - 11 allegations unsubstantiated
 - 7 ongoing investigations 4 reports directly to ITP that don't fall within 11.4
 - waiting for ITP response on 2 files
- 31 suspensions of 5 games or more

Additional Playing Rule 11 Suspensions

- 52 Coach Suspensions for 11.2 Game or Gross Misconducts
- 2 Coach Suspensions for 11.5 Threatening Officials
