



U13 AA HEAD COACH

The **Prairie Storm Minor Hockey Association (PSMHA)** is accepting applications for the position of the **U13 AA Head Coach**.

PSMHA is seeking an individual who wants to develop young athletes by instilling the values of PSMHA including hard work, commitment, determination and a positive and fun environment. Candidates should be able to demonstrate prior coaching experience (prior coaching at the U13 level is an asset), hockey knowledge, good communication skills and good organizational skills.

The **U13 AA Head Coach must have, or be able to achieve**, the following certifications:

- Development 1 (Certified) **or** High Performance 1
- The Shift Forward: Evolving Hockey Culture (previously Respect in Sport)
- Checking Certification
- Screening Requirements as per Hockey Saskatchewan
- Goaltending Certification

The **roles and responsibilities** of the job include:

- Work with the PSMHA Board of Directors on an as needed basis to maintain development programs for U13 aged players;
- Attend the U13 Fall Evaluations and continue to evaluate players through an exhibition series;
- Prepare and deliver a season plan including off ice requirements, practice plans & game line ups;
- Select qualified assistant coaches, team manager, and other team personnel as needed;
- Attend the U13 AA scheduling meeting in the fall to plan the PSMHA U13 AA season;
- Develop an ongoing program that provides a consistent experience for players & parents;
- Liaison with other AA coaches in the Association to develop long term program development;
- Assist in the fall development camps as required.

It is the preference of PSMHA to secure an independent coach (one without children on the team) however, this does not exclude parent coaches from applying.
