

HOCKEY SASKATCHEWAN MALE PLAYER ACCELERATION

THIS APPLICATION MUST BE SUBMITTED TO HOCKEY SASKATCHEWAN BY JANUARY 10TH

The Hockey Saskatchewan Male Development programs place a focus on the development of players within their specific age group, and not to displace players from their age Division by facilitating the movement of underage players. Underage players will only be considered if they are deemed to be an "Exceptional Player."

Only second-year U15-aged players will be considered for acceleration to the highest level of U18 hockey (AAA). There will be no acceleration permitted for U15-aged players to U18 AA.

In order to be considered for "Exceptional Player" status, applications must be submitted to Hockey Saskatchewan on or before January 10th.

- A. Applicants must fill out, in their entirety, the Player Acceleration Application Package and provide all the necessary documentation requested;
- B. Applications must include endorsement from the U18 AAA Team that the applicant wishes to register with.
- C. Applications will be evaluated by Hockey Saskatchewan staff who will ensure a scouting process has taken place and recommendations made to the Hockey Saskatchewan Board of Directors.
- D. No underage players will be granted a second tryout at the U18 AAA division.
- E. Decisions will be communicated to the player and applicable Host MHA(s) / Program in writing on or before May 1st.
- F. A \$250.00 non-refundable Application Fee must accompany all applications.
- G. Hockey Saskatchewan Male Sask First Program
 - Any Male player granted "exceptional player" status to register on an Under-18 AAA team as a second-year Under-15 (14-year-old) player must register and attend the Sask First Male Under-15 Program's regional camp. Following that camp, they shall be moved to the February event, bypassing the December event.
- Applications must include:
 - Personal Information;
 - Playing History (including statistics from the past three seasons);
 - Personal Resume; it should include academic standing, athletic achievements, leadership activities, community service, other extra-curricular activities (sports, clubs, etc.), academic awards and work experience (if any);
 - Personal Response (outlined on the following page);
 - Current Coach recommendation (utilizing the attached form);
 - o Current Teacher (or School Administrator) recommendation (utilizing the attached form);
 - Written commitment from AAA team they wish to play for.

- How Selections will be made:
 - Applicants will be evaluated by Hockey Saskatchewan;
 - Applications will be reviewed on their individual merit; taking into account the physical, emotional and social maturity of the athlete;
 - Feedback will be collected from the players Resident MHA or the MHA last registered with;
